Sheriff David Marshak wishes to announce the arrest of one:

**Garrett Noll
22 Years of Age
Festus, Mo.**

regarding the shooting of a female victim on March 31, 2018.

On March 31, 2018, Deputies with the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office responded to the Mapaville-Hematite Fire Protection District in regard to a victim of a gunshot. The subsequent investigation revealed the shooting occurred in the 4000 block of Hillsboro Hematite Road in Festus, Mo. Investigators contacted Garrett at his residence in the 4000 block of Hillsboro-Hematite Road, which has a shared driveway with a neighboring residence. According to statements made by Garrett, he observed the victim and her husband leaving the neighboring residence in a vehicle. Garrett believed the victim did not have a legitimate reason to be at the neighboring residence, due to an unrelated, previous trespasser in the area. According to Garrett, he fired a 'warning shot' from a firearm as the victim was leaving in her vehicle. As the vehicle continued to drive away, Garrett fired two additional shots, one of which passed through the vehicle and struck the victim in her head. The victim was transported to an area hospital, where she was treated and later released.

It was determined the victim and her husband had valid reason to be at the neighboring residence.

Probable cause was developed during the interviews which led to the issuance of warrants through the 23rd Judicial Circuit Court in Jefferson County for:

Assault 2nd

with an attached bond of:

\$10,000 cash or surety

Garrett is considered a pre-trial detainee.
