Sheriff David Marshak is seeking the assistance of the public in the following investigation:

On April 24, 2018, The Jefferson County Sheriff's Office received a report of property damage at:

**Combs Ministorage
2100 block of US Hwy 67
Festus, Mo.**

Review of on-site surveillance camera footage revealed that:

2 unknown suspects

entered upon the lot of the storage facility at approximately 0212 hours. While at the storage lot, the two suspects caused property damage to the doors and locks of 13 individual storage units, allowing them to gain entry into the lockers.

Investigators were able to locate images of one of the suspects from the surveillance footage.

The Sheriff's Office is contacting victims to determine if property was removed from the storage lockers.
